Amber Canite read February minutes, stand approved.

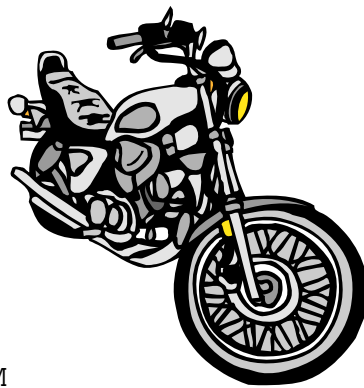
